Applicants must meet the following minimum qualifications:

- Must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age by the application deadline
- Be a U.S. citizen, be a high school graduate or graduate equivalency diploma (GED)
- Have a Pennsylvania driver's license before appointment.
- Meet the Municipal Police Officers Education and Training Commission standards for physical and mental fitness.
- Must not have a disqualifying criminal record.

The Township follows the Civil Service process. This includes a written and oral examination, a physical agility/ability test, medical and psychological exams, drug screen, and a thorough background investigation. This preliminary application must be completed and returned to the Muhlenberg Police Department by **Friday, April 17, 2020, by 4:00 PM.**

Once an applicant passes the written and physical agility/ability tests, a \$35 non-refundable fee in check or money order, made payable to Muhlenberg Township, is required to continue to the oral interview exam and subsequent processing.

Completed applications may be dropped off in person at the police department business office during normal business hours or you may forward the police application via certified mail – return receipt requested.
